Exporting Your List of Data Use Agreements from Agreements-DUA

From a report in Agreements-DUA, you can export a list of certain outside activities that *may be* used to help you complete the Biosketch and Other Support disclosure requirements for sponsored projects.

To Export a DUA List:

- 1. Login to OAIR at dua.harvard.edu.
- 2. Click on the following link to run the report: Harvard Report: Agreements ad hoc report.

Note: You must be logged into the system already before you try to run the report.

3. In the report window, scroll all the way to the right and click the **Export** button.
